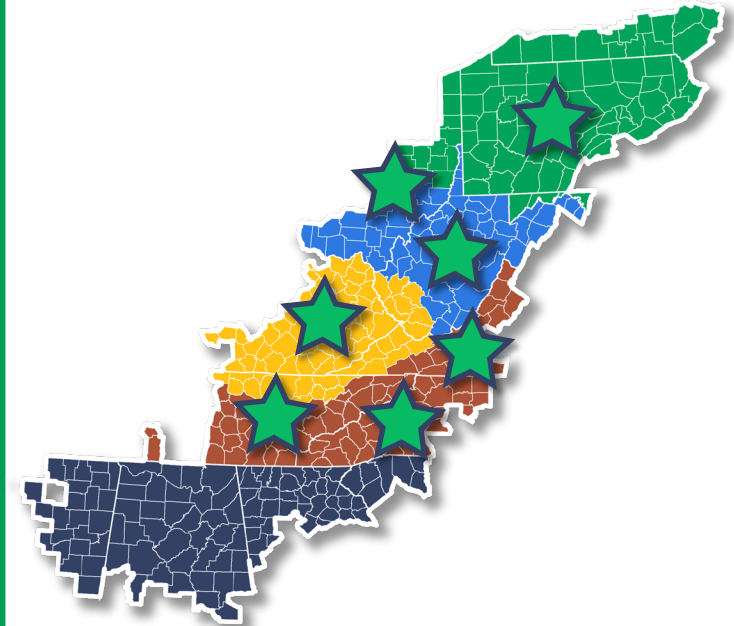

This project will explore workforce gaps and assets to support the emerging field of industrialized construction across 211 counties across seven Appalachian states by convening regional stakeholders and creating a training roadmap that catalyzes industrial economic revitalization in Central Appalachia.

Virginia Tech and their partners bring a total of \$244,279 in matching funds to this total project. The project will develop a comprehensive implementation plan over the 12-month performance period.
