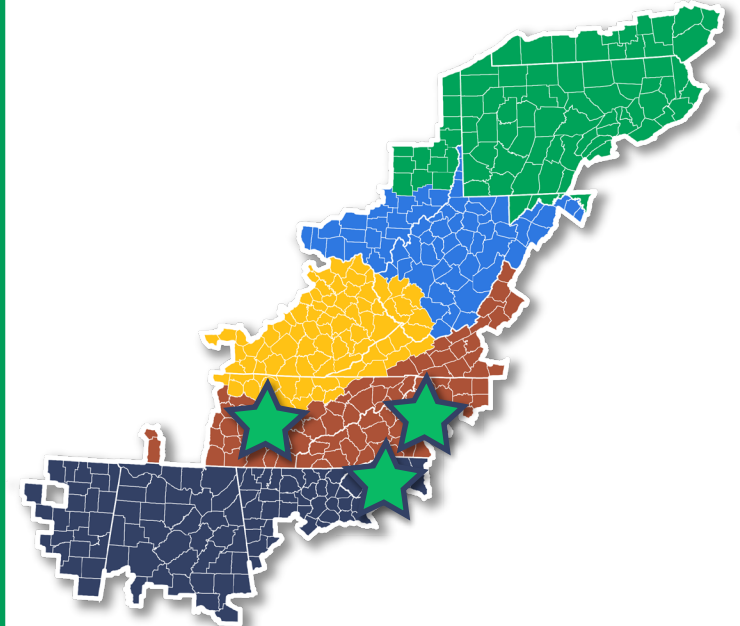

## PROJECT SUMMARY

Land of Sky Regional Council will use ARISE funding to develop a strategic growth plan for Appalachia's forest sector industry. Impacting 63 counties across North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee, this project will form a multi-state task force to assess the current state of forest sector markets, explore future economic opportunities in Southern Appalachia and strategize ways to attract private investment to expand the sector.

Land of Sky and partners bring a combined \$258,000 in matching funds to this project. Over a one-year performance period, the project will develop one actionable implementation plan for sustainable economic growth.
